- Free transport home within East Lancs is available to anyone working Friday or Saturday last shifts. Please book this when you sign in at the festival.
- Refreshments and breakfast rolls will be available to people helping during set up and take down. Everyone must bring and wear their own safety shoes during these days.
 - High Vis vests and gloves will be provided and must be worn at all times.
- Before starting work on any shift, please make sure you have read the Festival Health and Safety as well as the Hygiene Handbooks. These can be viewed online via the festival web site
- You are reminded this festival runs in Jan/Feb, so please bring warm clothing.
- Festival works trip is open to all workers there is a fully refundable £5
 deposit to secure your place. IF YOU PAID £5 IN 2020 THEN YOU DO NOT
 NEED TO PAY AGAIN. See the staffing officer when you sign on.
- Where timeslots are already fully staffed then the Staffing Officer may have to decline your offer to work.
